

WHAT TO DO AFTER A WATER MAIN BREAK

After experiencing a water main break, the water system is flushed by the water department. In most cases, you will not notice any difference in your water, but there is a chance you may have air in the line or notice a reddish or murky color. Flushing your system at home for 5 minutes after the water has been restored is a good practice and should take care of those problems. You can flush using cold water from your kitchen sink.
